



Stevens Amendment

The Stevens Amendment, <u>PUBLIC LAW 101-166</u>, <u>SECTION 511</u>, is an appropriations provision that requires grantees of the Department of Labor (DOL), Health and Human Services (HHS), and Education to disclose for a grant program the percent of the costs financed with federal funds.

- Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) programs are federally supported 100% by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling \$21,178,764 with \$0 (0%) state, local and/or non-governmental funds.
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) programs are federally supported 100% by the U.S. Department of Human Services as part of an award totaling \$42,123,819 with \$0 (0%) state, local, and/or non-governmental funds.
- Discretionary grants are federally supported by the U.S. Department of Labor as part of an award totaling \$16,866,499, with \$0 (0%) being state, local and/or non-governmental funds.
